**Description:** Many people with a common heart rhythm problem called atrial fibrillation must temporarily stop taking their "blood thinner" medication (e.g. warfarin) around the time of a surgery. These patients are commonly given shorter-acting blood thinners ("bridging anticoagulants") hoping to prevent strokes. However, peri-procedural use of these shorter-acting bridging anticoagulants can actually lead to life-threatening bleeding events without preventing strokes. This research will develop a re-organized model of care for patients with atrial fibrillation to prevent harmful use of bridging anticoagulants when patients with atrial fibrillation undergo common surgical procedures.
